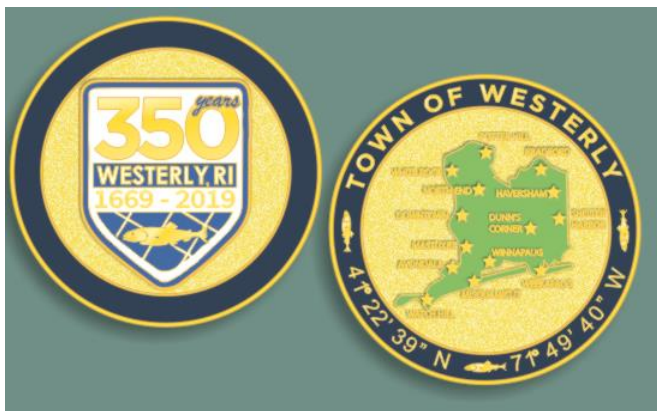

WESTERLY RI CELEBRATES 350TH ANNIVERSARY WITH A MEDAL



Celebrating a shared history. Unifying neighbors. Highlighting local business. Fostering community pride.

With the start of the town's 350th year on January 1, 2019, bells rang out all over town. From the tiniest bell in a child's hand to the bells and carillons in churches and both old and "new" Town Halls, we rang in our birthday greetings to Westerly Rhode Island. The news that there would be a commemorative medal struck to mark this event made my numismatist's heart jump. Only 350 medals will be struck. A base metal, cast with brilliant gold colored tones and colored enamel depicting the 350th Anniversary Logo on the obverse and the dates of 1669-2019. On the reverse is a green map of the town set on a gold background, showing the villages that comprise Westerly, each represented by a gold star and village name. It has a blue rim containing the nautical coordinates and the three salmon from Westerly's Town Seal, it is a handsome medal. The origin of the Town's "Three Salmon" logo came from the Native Tribes use of a seine net to catch the salmon where the present day Pawcatuck River Bridge is located today. The medal was designed by Joodie Symington of In Designs of Westerly. The medals are available at the Ocean State Chamber of Commerce, 1 Chamber Way, Westerly and only \$10. You folks who collect exonomia may want to run and get one because the supply is dwindling. I will bring my medal to the February meeting.

U S MINT TO RELEASE APOLLO 11 COINS ON JANUARY 24th



The United States Mint is proud to present the Apollo 11 50th Anniversary Commemorative Coin Program to celebrate the first manned Moon landing on July 20, 1969, and the efforts of the United States space program leading up to this historic event. All coins share common designs and are curved. The Apollo 11 50th Anniversary Five Ounce Proof Silver Dollar is the first United States coin with a proof finish, reeded edge, and curved shape. Obverse: This design features the inscriptions "MERCURY," "GEMINI," and "APOLLO," separated by phases of the Moon, and a footprint on the lunar surface, which together represent the efforts of the United States space program leading up to the first manned Moon landing. Additional

inscriptions include "2019," "IN GOD WE TRUST," and "LIBERTY."

Reverse: This design features a representation of a close-up of the famous "Buzz Aldrin on the Moon" photograph taken July 20, 1969, that shows just the visor and part of the helmet of astronaut Buzz Aldrin. The reflection in Buzz Aldrin's helmet includes astronaut Neil Armstrong, the United States flag, and the lunar lander. Inscriptions include "UNITED STATES OF AMERICA," "ONE DOLLAR," and "E PLURIBUS UNUM." Surcharges in the amount of \$35 for each \$5 gold coin sold; \$10 for each silver dollar sold; \$5 for each half dollar sold; and \$50 for each five ounce silver dollar sold are authorized to be paid to three recipient organizations. Half of the total is authorized to be paid to the Smithsonian National Air and Space Museum's "Destination Moon" exhibit; one quarter to the Astronauts Memorial Foundation; and one quarter to the Astronauts Scholarship Foundation.

The introductory price will be in effect from noon ET on January 24, 2019, through 3 p.m. ET on February 25, 2019, after which the regular price will be in effect.
