NUMISMATIC NEWS: PRESIDENTIAL SILVER MEDALS Each Commander-in-Chief has had a bronze medal created by the United States Mint in their honor. Starting in 2018, these medals will be offered in one ounce of 99.9% silver with a stunning matte finish. The series opens with America's first and second Presidents, George Washington and John Adams. There will be four new medals each year beginning in 2019.



The bronze medals of the Presidents are available as well and are available up through the 44th President. This a cost-effective way to enjoy the series.
